

## Uniform and Equipment

Students at Trinity Academy Cathedral are expected to achieve standards of excellence in all areas of their academy life including appearance; therefore it is important that a smart uniform is worn at all times. The intention is to instil pride, support positive behaviour and discipline, encourage identity with and support for the academy ethos. Another key reason for the academy uniform is to ensure students of all races and social and economic backgrounds feel welcome and protect students from social pressures to dress in a particular way. Students at the academy are expected to wear correct uniform at all times, including when entering and exiting the academy. When uniform is worn inappropriately or incorrect pieces of uniform are worn, appropriate sanctions will be put in place.

### BLAZERS

All students must wear a black blazer with the academy logo. This must be worn at all times around the academy site with sleeves rolled down.

### TROUSERS

Trousers for both girls and boys must be straight legged, full length black polyester or cotton material with no coloured stitching or decoration. Skin tight trousers are not permitted. Students must not wear trousers where ankles can be seen.

### PE KIT

Navy and sky blue academy t-shirt with logo. Optional academy long sleeved top. Plain navy shorts/tracksuit bottoms/socks. Sports Hijabs are available for purchase directly from the academy through ParentPay. Appropriate sports trainers and plastic/metal studded boots. No pump style trainers are allowed (for e.g. Converse/Vans).

### SHIRTS/BLOUSES

All students must wear a white cotton shirt or blouse with a buttoned collar. This can be long or short sleeved.

### SKIRT

As an alternative to trousers, the academy blue tartan skirt can be worn. Skirts must also be of appropriate length (knee length or below). Black tights must be worn at all times. No other skirts are permitted to be worn.

### CAPA JUNIORS PRACTICAL KIT

CAPA Juniors t-shirt and hoodie.

Boys: Plain black shorts or tracksuit bottoms, black unitard, white socks, black split sole ballet shoes.

Girls: Plain thick black leggings or black leotard with black tights, pink ballet tights, pink split sole ballet shoes. A black ballet skirt may also be worn (optional).

### TIE

Academy ties must be worn at all times.

### JUMPER

The academy branded jumper is optional.

### SHOES/SOCKS

Shoes for both girls and boys must be all black, at and without any buckles/logos or decorative features. No black trainers or boots. Plain black socks (no ankle socks).

### MAKE-UP/ JEWELLERY

Make-up, false eyelashes, coloured nail varnish and false nails are not permitted. Jewellery must be limited to one silver or gold stud in each ear lobe only. Jewellery on the hands must be limited to one ring only. No facial piercings or tongue piercings allowed.
